

Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology High Performance Sports Academy Scholarships 2020

Background

The Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology (Toi Ohomai) High Performance Sports Academy Scholarship programme aims to support students to achieve high academic results in the course of their choice, whilst pursuing excellence in their sporting code.

Value and Benefits

Up to five High Performance Sports Academy Scholarships are available to students studying a Toi Ohomai course in 2020, which will cover up to one full year of course fees; or alternatively, if the scholarship recipient is eligible for a NZ government fees free subsidy, a study grant to the value of \$5,000 will be paid directly to the recipient.

In addition, scholarship recipients will have free access to sport and fitness facilities on campus, as well as to a high performance manager who can provide academic, sporting and lifestyle support. Recipients are also allocated ten hours per annum access to sports support services, such as sports science testing. They will also receive a High Performance Sports Academy kit, consisting of a tracksuit and t-shirt.

Eligibility

Open to all current and prospective students who are intending to study at Toi Ohomai in 2020. Open to New Zealand citizens and permanent residents only.

Open to students participating in a sport that is recognised on the Sport New Zealand list of national sports organisations.

The scholarship is for one year. Past recipients may apply again, however preference will be given to first time scholarship applicants.

Rugby playing students who wish to apply for Toi Ohomai High Performance Scholarships should approach Bay of Plenty Rugby to access rugby specific scholarships.

Criteria

Applicants must clearly demonstrate:

- a record of academic achievement
- that they meet the entry criteria for their chosen course
- significant sporting achievement(s) to date, and the potential to further excel in their sporting code
- leadership qualities

Each applicant must provide a one-page statement detailing these attributes and explaining why they would value this scholarship.

Two further references from people who know the applicant well (who are ideally not family members; and one of whom should be a current or recent coach) must also be submitted.

It is important to attach other evidence, such as photocopies of exam results and school reports, to the application.

Consideration of the suitability of applications will also be subject to Toi Ohomai's capability, in conjunction with local agencies, to provide access to facilities and support appropriate to the applicant's chosen sport.

Selection Panel

All applications will be considered by the selection panel, who will then select the successful recipients. The panel will consist of several key Toi Ohomai staff, including the High Performance Sports Academy manager, as well as a member from the wider Bay of Plenty sporting community.

- The selection panel may contact referees on a confidential basis for further information.
- The selection panel may consult with representatives of relevant sporting codes to assess the standing of any achievements listed in the applications.
- The selection panel may, at its discretion, require the applicant to undertake an interview.

Closing Date

Applications close on Friday, 25 October 2019.

1. The recipient is expected to behave in a positive manner at all times.
