

Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology TrustPower Scholarship (Environmental Management) 2018

Background

The scholarship is funded from the interest earned from funds invested after the disposal of electricity company shares by Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology in 1995.

It is to provide funding to a student who has been identified as a person who demonstrates attributes likely to help them succeed on the programme, and go on to make a contribution in the field of environmental management. The financial need of the applicant will also be a consideration in selecting the recipient.

Value

\$1,500. Paid by cheque.

Eligibility

Applications are open to any Year 1 student planning to enter Year 2 of the Diploma in Environmental Management Level 6 at Tauranga campus. Open to New Zealand citizens and permanent residents only.

Scope of the award

The scholarship is a single award to assist with study related expenses. A certificate of recognition will also be awarded to the recipient.

Criteria

Recipients will be selected based on their application clearly demonstrating to the selection panel that they have:

1. The ability and commitment to succeed in academic study at this level
2. A proven ability to work well in a team situation
3. An interest in and commitment to the environment which would make them a worthy recipient of the Trustpower scholarship (Environmental Management).
