

Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology High Performance Academy Sports Scholarships 2018

Background

Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology, High Performance Academy Sports Scholarship Programme aims to provide support for students to achieve a high academic standard in a programme of their choice, whilst seeking excellence in their sporting code.

Value and Benefits

There are up to eight sport scholarships available in 2018 to students studying at Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology (Toi Ohomai) which cover full fees paid for a maximum of one year. In addition, recipients will be granted access to sport and fitness facilities, as well as access to a High Performance Manager for education, sporting and lifestyle support. Successful students are also allocated ten hours per annum access to sports support services such as sports science testing. They will also be given a High Performance Academy kit, consisting of track suit and t-shirt.

Eligibility

Open to all current and prospective students of Toi Ohomai. Open to New Zealand citizens and permanent residents only. Open to students participating in a sport that is recognised on the Sport New Zealand list of national sports organisations. Existing scholarship students and Pathway to Podium athletes are encouraged to apply for 2018.

Criteria

The recipient will be selected based on their application clearly demonstrating:

- · Academic achievement
- · Meeting the entry criteria for the programme of choice
- · Significant sporting achievement(s) to date and potential to further excel in their sporting code
- · Leadership qualities

The applicant will also be required to provide a brief written supporting statement on why they would like the opportunity to take up the study award as well as two written referee's, one of which should be from their coach.

Attach evidence such as photocopies of exam results, reports, and references etc. to their application.

Consideration of the suitability of applications will also be subject to the Toi Ohomai's capability, in conjunction with local agencies, to provide access to facilities and support appropriate to the applicants chosen sport.

Awarding Panel

The scholarship will be awarded to students selected by the panel. The panel will consist of Toi Ohomai's CEO, Group Leader for Sport and Recreation, High Performance Academy Manager, Marketing & Communications Manager and a member of the wider Bay of Plenty sporting community.

Selection

- The selection panel considers all applications and may contact referees on a confidential basis for further information.
- The selection panel may consult with representatives of the relevant sporting codes to assess the standing of any achievements listed in the applications.
- · The selection panel may, at its discretion, require the applicant to undertake an interview.

Closing Date

The final date for applications will be Friday, 27 October 2017.

- 6. The recipient is to mention, when possible, Toi Ohomai sports scholarships when being interviewed by media throughout the year.
