

Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology Study Award 2018

Background

The Toi Ohomai Study Awards are intended to be an incentive for people from the Eastern and Western Bay of Plenty to achieve qualifications with an aim to minimising the financial barrier for the second chance learner.

These awards are for applicants with previous work experience and/or an evident career aspiration.

The personal and financial circumstances of applicants will be also considered.

(Note: As there are a number of Toi Ohomai scholarships available to local secondary school leavers, people under 18 years of age will not be considered for these awards).

In all cases, the award will be pending the individual meeting the programme entry criteria and being accepted onto their intended study programme.

Value

The award will provide a one-off fee reduction at commencement of a Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology Certificate, Diploma or Degree programme.

10 awards of \$500 for part-time study and 15 awards of \$1,000 for full-time study will be available.

Eligibility

Preference will be given to students from the Toi Ohomai Bay of Plenty and South Waikato catchment.

Note: This award is primarily for applicants commencing a Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology programme. **Applicants already undertaking study at Toi Ohomai Institute of Technology will be approved at the discretion of the decision panel.**

Criteria

Applicants must demonstrate they have:

- the necessary motivation to achieve a tertiary qualification
- the ability to meet the academic demands of their programme of study

Consideration will also be given to the applicant's personal and financial circumstances.

Closing Date

The final date for applications will be Friday, 12 January 2018 for Semester 1 programmes and Friday, 22 June 2018 for Semester 2 programmes.
