

Toi Ohomai Statutory Declaration

This needs to be completed if you are applying under the English language entry criteria of completing your schooling in the English language and/or if you are applying for Special Admission.

This declaration must be given in front of a person authorised to witness a statutory declaration. To complete certification, a signature is required, with the name and title of the person certifying shown legibly below their signature.

A full list of potential persons authorised to witness a statutory declaration made in New Zealand can be obtained from section 9 of the Oaths and Declarations Act 1957, and includes the following:

- an enrolled barrister and solicitor of the High Court of New Zealand
- a Justice of the Peace (you can find a list of Justices of the Peace in the New Zealand Yellow Pages)
- a notary public
- a Registrar or Deputy Registrar of the District Court, High Court, Court of Appeal or Supreme Court.

The following persons are authorised to witness a statutory declaration made outside New Zealand:

- in a Commonwealth country other than New Zealand – a Judge, a Commissioner of Oaths, a notary public, a Justice of the Peace, or any person authorised by the law of that country to administer an oath there for the purpose of a judicial proceeding, a Commonwealth representative, or a solicitor of the High Court of New Zealand
- in a country other than a Commonwealth country – a Commonwealth representative, a Judge, a notary public, or a solicitor of the High Court of New Zealand.

WARNING: Should you apply for an immigration adviser licence, the provision of false information with regard to your application for the Graduate Diploma in New Zealand Immigration Advice Level 7 is an offence under the Immigration Advisers Licensing Act 2007 with penalties of imprisonment of up to two years and/or a fine of up to \$10,000 and will result in your application for a licence being refused.
