The following persons are authorised to witness a statutory declaration made outside New Zealand:

- in a Commonwealth country other than New Zealand a Judge, a Commissioner of Oaths, a notary public, a Justice of the
 Peace, or any person authorised by the law of that country to administer an oath there for the purpose of a judicial proceeding,
 a Commonwealth representative, or a solicitor of the High Court of New Zealand
- in a country other than a Commonwealth country a Commonwealth representative, a Judge, a notary public, or a solicitor of the High Court of New Zealand.
