When quoting directly or indirectly (paraphrase) from a source, the source must be acknowledged by you.

The full bibliographic details of all the sources that you utilise for your assignment must be recorded in a *Reference List* at the end of your assignment.

The references are entered in alphabetical order by the author's surname.
